



BIRD FEEDING TIDBIT: IT HAS BEEN SUGGESTED THAT THERE HAVE BEEN INSTANCES OF BIRDS CHOKING ON PEANUT BUTTER STUFFED INTO PINE CONES. A WAY AROUND THIS PROBLEM IS TO MIX PEANUT BUTTER WITH CORNMEAL AND SUET. (SEE FOLLOWING:)

RECIPE: 1 CUP CRUNCHY PEANUT BUTTER, 1 CUP LARD, 2 CUPS QUICK OATS, 2 CUPS CORNMEAL, 1 CUP FLOUR, 1/3 CUP SUGAR: MELT PEANUT BUTTER AND LARD TOGETHER. STIR IN REMAINING INGREDIENTS. POUR INTO SQUARE FREEZER CONTAINERS SO MIXTURE IS ABOUT 1-1/2" THICK. COOL AND CUT INTO SQUARES. STORE EXTRA SQUARES IN FREEZER.
