DECEMBER 19, SATURDAY. ANNUAL WINTER BIRD COUNT IN RACINE AREA. Every Hoy member is asked to participate in their own yards, nearby parks, or in an assigned county area. We will drive or walk around small areas to identify and count as many birds as possible. These yearly counts are extremely important to track bird population trends. It's a busy time of year, but please set aside the morning, afternoon or whole day to help in this fun outdoor event. Less experienced birders can be paired with those more experienced, if desired. "CATS INDOORS CAMPAIGN"

In Sept. the Hoy Board voted to fund the printing of 1000 Cats
Indoors brochures. This project is a joint effort by the American Bird Conservancy, American Humane Assoc. & the Humane Society of the US. Its purpose is to inform the public about the harm outdoor cats can have on wildlife and ground nesting birds. The brochures will be distributed by Countryside Humane Society to cat adopters. Hoy's name will be stamped on the back.

EAGLE WATCHING DAYS

Jan. 16, begins Eagle Watching Days in Sauk City and Prairie du Sac. Bald Eagles gather here on the Wisconsin River because the strong current below the dam keeps the river from freezing, allowing the eagles access to fish. A group field trip is planned leaving Racine at 8 AM and returning by 5 or 6 PM. Viewing will be from within vehicles or outside, so dress appropriately. More info will be in the Jan. newsletter.

GOOD NEWS FOR PEREGRINES??

The US Fish & Wildlife Service is considered removing the Pergrine Falcon from the Federal List of Endangered Species. Our Wisconsin Peregrine Society is against this move for several reasons, including: more time is needed for birds in the Eastern US to prove their ability to nest in natural areas, currently they rely mainly on man-made structures for nesting; there is no emergency that warrants immediate de-listing nor scientific evidence demanding such an action.
